Students in 3-8 grade complete the MAP (Measure of Academic Progress) test twice a year in the Fall and Spring. Students are tested in Reading, Math, Science, and new this year Language. For the Fall MAP testing during this 2023-2024 school year our students at St. Ambrose performed very well as a whole.

You will notice that in the left column our St. Ambrose classes exceeded the average of both the Diocese and the nation in 24 out of 28 areas assessed. In the areas that we fell short of the Diocesan average our classes were not far behind. The column on the right provides a comparison from the test given during April of 2023. The first number shows how far ahead or behind the average of the Diocese our classes were at that time in comparison to their peers. The number on the right shows how far our classes are ahead or behind using this Fall test result. You will notice that in 13 of the 15 categories our classes improved upon their comparison to their peers from last year. The Math results are the most telling. In previous years most of our classes were well behind the Diocesan average on the Math test. This year, all of our classes exceeded the Diocesan average in Math with the exception of 1, and that class was only 1.5 points behind the Diocese.
