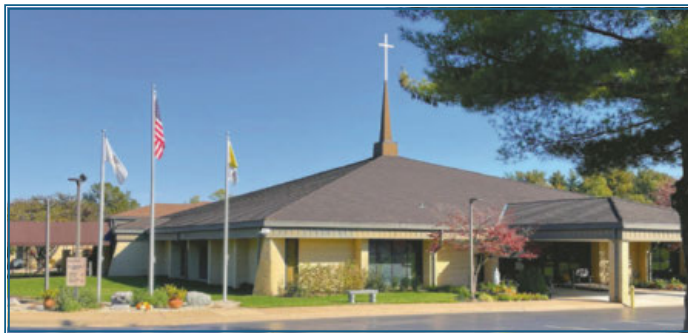

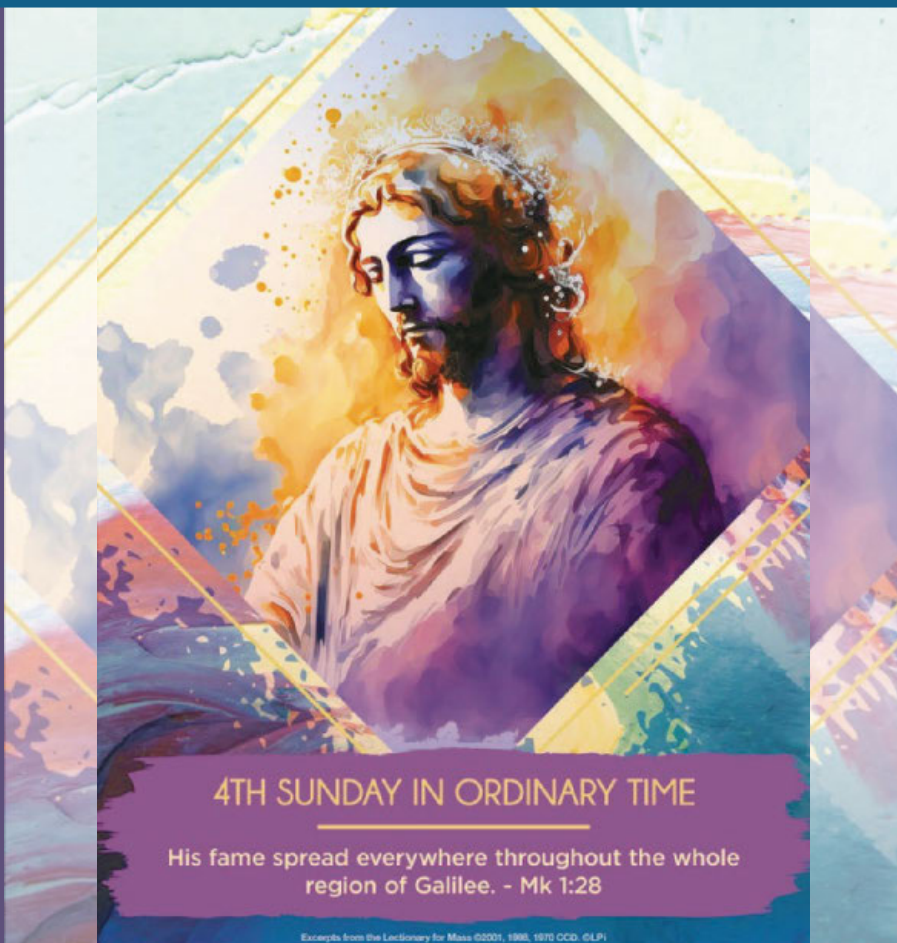

Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Ambrose Parish Family,

This weekend begins the annual celebration of Catholic Schools Week in the United States. The theme is "United in Faith and Community."

All my life, I have been associated with Catholic Schools. I attended Our Lady of Perpetual Help School, St. Louis Preparatory Seminary North in Florissant, Cardinal Glennon College, Kenrick Seminary, University of St. Mary of the Lake, and Aquinas Institute of Theology. My service as a priest has included parishes with Catholic Schools, teaching at a Catholic High School and serving as the Campus Minister and Theology professor at a Catholic University. In all of these ministries, Catholic identity was and continues to be essential.

Catholic identity is much more than crucifixes on the walls. It is much more than priests and sisters on the faculty or staff. It is much more than weekly attendance at Mass. Catholic identity is a lifestyle. Catholic identity upholds the teaching of the Catholic Church, rooted in Jesus Christ. Catholic identity is living as faithful followers of Jesus in the classroom, on the playground, on weekends and breaks, at all extracurricular events, in the parking lot, in our homes and neighborhoods. I have often stressed that distinction between a Catholic School and a private school. A Catholic School has as a primary focus the formation of the whole person: spiritual, intellectual, physical and psychological. The foundation of this formation is a life rooted in the teaching and example of Jesus Christ. Our Catholic identity, our faith, should permeate everything we do, everything we are. In other words, Jesus MUST be the center of our lives and ministry. If not, we will become merely a "private" school.

The motto of this Catholic Schools Week is "United in Faith and Community." Faith, first. Always.

In today's Gospel, the evil spirits recognized Jesus as the Holy One of God. Some of the first to recognize Jesus and his mission were evil spirits. They knew they had met their match. These evil spirits would haunt and taunt Jesus throughout his life, but he always "put them in their place." Jesus clearly had power over the forces of evil. We have been given the same power. We have Jesus. We have the Holy Spirit. We have faith.



May God bless you and those you know and love! May God bless everyone in ways only God can know.

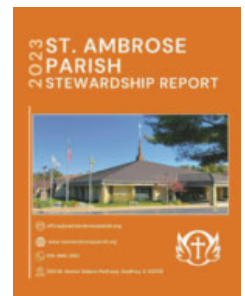

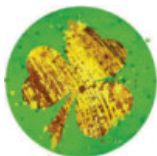

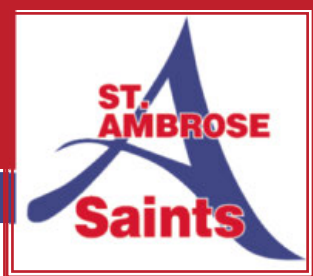
