Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Ambrose Parish Family,

There is much suffering in the world. Some suffering we bring upon ourselves by choices we make. Other suffering is brought on by the choices others make. Some suffering makes no sense at all. At some point in life, everyone will experience suffering and pain, sorrow and despair. The Book of Job tells a story of a man who was to the eyes of most, a good and holy man. As a "test" to prove his faithfulness to God, Satan asked God to bring upon Job unwarranted suffering. Job remained faithful through it all, even though he did not understand why he was suffering. We have to remember that the common understanding of suffering was that it was divine punishment for one's sin or the sin of one's ancestors. Suffering IS a result of SIN in the sense that prior to the fall of Adam and Eve, everything was perfect. When sin entered the world, that perfection was lost and suffering entered the world.

There is much suffering, often silent suffering, among our parishioners who are good people and "don't deserve it". What can we do? Be present. Offer our support and prayers. Help them as needed (driving, shopping, cooking, cleaning). Listen. Be honest and admit you don't have all the answers. Hold them. I look to the example of Mary Magdalene in the Passion story. She would have done anything to stop the suffering of her dear friend Jesus ... but she was powerless to do so. She did what I call "the next best thing". She was with Jesus through his passion so that when He looked at her, He would see a face of love in the crowd of hate.

Perhaps that is our mission: to be the face of love.

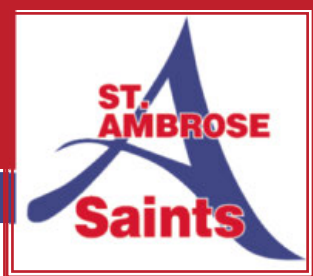
Join us for a delightful evening-long workshop. Reconnect with your spouse, review the golden moments and successes of the last year, and plan and dream for the year ahead.

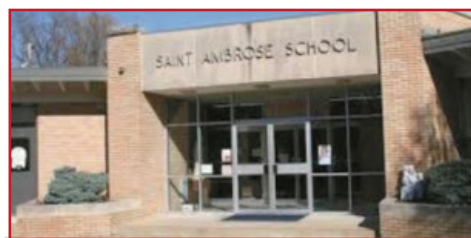
