It's that time of year again. LENT. Lent begins on Wednesday, February 14, with the blessing and distribution of ashes. Masses at St. Ambrose will be celebrated at 8:15 a.m. (School Mass) and 7:00 p.m. There will also be a Liturgy of the Word with Distribution of Ashes at 2:15 p.m. to accommodate those who will be picking up children from school, yet all are welcome.

11. **Sunday Evening Prayer** at 4:00 p.m. on the Sundays of Lent
12. **Communal Penance Service** in mid-March (date and time TBD)
13. **40 Days for Life** (*silent prayer witness*) on Wednesday, March 13, at the Hope Clinic in Granite City 7:00 a.m.-7:00 p.m. (*One hour commitment*)

Ashbury Village is part of St. Ambrose Parish and as such, we are privileged to provide the sacraments for the Catholic residents. Unfortunately, at this time, there is no priest available to provide the weekly Saturday Mass that has become part of their routine. However, we are committed to providing a **Liturgy of the Word with Distribution of Communion** (Communion Service) to the residents of Ashbury Village on Saturdays at 3:30 p.m. We are in discussion with the staff at Ashbury to consider other ways to minister to their community. If you are interested in assisting with this ministry, please contact Deacon Jay. Thanks so much for your consideration.

Sunday's Readings

First Reading:

"As long as the sore is on him he shall declare himself unclean, since he is in fact unclean. He shall dwell apart, making his abode outside the camp." (Lv 13:8)

Psalm:

I turn to you, Lord, in time of trouble, and you fill me with the joy of salvation. (Ps 32)

Second Reading:

Whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do everything for the glory of God. (1Cor 10:31)

Gospel:

Moved with pity, he stretched out his hand, touched him, and said to him, "I do will it. Be made clean." The leprosy left him immediately, and he was made clean. (Mk 1:41-42)

LENTEN REGULATIONS for CATHOLICS

1. **ABSTINENCE** – Everyone 14 years of age and over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.
2. **FAST** – Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 is required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is permitted. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to each person's needs, but together these two should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids (including milk and fruit juices) are allowed.
3. To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.
