

Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Ambrose Parish Family,

On this Third Sunday of Lent, we celebrate the first of three Scrutinies with our Elect as they prepare for the Easter Sacraments. The Word of God for the Mass (8:00 a.m.) during which the Scrutiny takes place invites us to reflect on Jesus as the **"living water"**. It is Jesus who can quench our thirst for life and freedom from sin.

At the other Masses, we will hear the **Ten Commandments** as given to Moses. The first three of these commandments centers around our relationship with God: You shall have no other gods besides me; you shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain; keep holy the Lord's Day.

The anger of Jesus in the Gospel stems from the misuse of the **Temple**, where the Jewish people would come together to worship God. The use of the Temple as a place of worship was overshadowed by buying and selling. The focus was no longer on God.

Jesus cleared the Temple so that it could return to its original purpose as a place to worship the one true God.

Looking ahead: Parish Penance Service followed by Evening Prayer on Sunday, March 17 beginning at 3:30 p.m. Please make plans to attend this celebration of God's love and mercy.

Sunday's Readings

First Reading:

In those days, God delivered all these commandments: "I, the LORD am your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, that place of slavery. You shall not have other gods besides me." (Ex 20:1-3)

Psalm:

Lord, you have the words of everlasting life. (Ps 19)

Second Reading:

We proclaim Christ crucified, a stumbling block to Jews and foolishness to Gentiles, but to those who are called, Jews and Greeks alike, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God. (1 Cor 1:23-24)

Gospel:

Jesus answered and said to them, "Destroy this temple and in three days I will raise it up." (Jn 2:19)







FAITH FORMATION CORNER
Peace, Deacon Bill Kessler

Starting this weekend, we have a chance to join with our 7 candidates above the age of reason (7) and our two that are under 2, who are preparing for Baptism at Easter. There will be special Readings and special Rites Father will offer for those to be Baptized. Those are called Scrutinies.

The Scrutinies are three special rites that help prepare the Elect, those participating in the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA), to enter the Catholic Church. They take place during the period of OCIA formation known as Purification and Enlightenment, near the end of their formation. Our Bishop mentioned this period two weeks ago at our Cathedral.

The season of Lent involves a more intense period of examination and preparation for the Elect, and hopefully for those of us already living the Catholic faith. Though they are meant for the OCIA Elect, the Scrutinies can help all Catholics seeking to live a life of continuous conversion.

The purpose of the Scrutinies is "to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective, or as sinful" in the hearts of the Elect and to "strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good." (Quotes from the Ritual Text for RCIA #141).

Our entire Parish is welcome to pray for and support our candidates in prayer for in this final period of their Preparation for Baptism. We thank God for this great gift of others who seek to follow Jesus in our St. Ambrose Parish.

Thank you for all of the kind expressions of sympathies for the loss of my youngest brother, Stephen. Our family will gather together for Mass when most can join in the Eucharist to say thanks to God for Stephen. When we Kesslers get together with siblings, their spouses, their children and grandchildren, there are more than 120 of us. Prayers that all travel safely.
May Stephen rest in peace.


