Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Ambrose Parish Family,

This weekend marks the mid-way point of our Lenten Season, traditionally called "**Laetare**" (let us rejoice) Sunday. The Church marks this mid-way point by wearing rose-colored vestments instead of the usual Lenten violet.

The Word of God this weekend tells the story of Moses and the serpent mounted on the pole and God's power to heal those bitten by serpents so they might live. The connection with the Gospel is that the followers of **JESUS** look to Jesus "mounted on a pole", the **CROSS**, and through the power of God, experience healing through the forgiveness of sins.

In the *Mass for the **Second Scrutiny*** (celebrated at 10:30 a.m.) with our Elect, those preparing for the Easter Sacraments, we heard the story of the man born blind and how he was healed by Jesus. We prayed with our Elect that their eyes and ours will be opened to recognize our need for Jesus' healing. Lent is a time of reconciliation for the Baptized.

On Tuesday of this week, in addition to Mass at St. Ambrose, I will celebrate Mass at **Ashbury Village** at 3:00 p.m. The plan is to offer Mass at Ashbury on the second Tuesday of the month. Parishioners are welcome.

On the third Tuesday of the month, in addition to Mass at St. Ambrose, I will celebrate Mass at **Cedarhurst Senior Living** in Godfrey at 1:30 p.m. Parishioners are welcome.

Wednesday, March 13, is the St. Ambrose Day for **40 Days for Life** at the Hope Clinic in Granite City. Thanks to those who have volunteered to be a physical presence and witness to LIFE. Please continue to pray for a deeper respect for all human life, beginning in the womb.

The third and **final Scrutiny** with our Elect will take place at the 4:30 p.m. Mass on Saturday, March 16, 2024. Please continue to pray for those who are preparing for the Sacraments of Christian Initiation at Easter.



St. Ambrose will offer a **Communal Penance Service** NEXT SUNDAY, **March 17 at 3:30 p.m.**, concluding with the Sunday Evening Prayer and Rosary (for those who can stay). Frs. Frank and Louis and I will be available for individual confession and absolution. To prepare for the celebration of the Sacrament, please review the Examination of Conscience provided below.

May God bless you as we enter this home stretch of Lent.

Have I been a good Christian witness to my children in what I say and do?

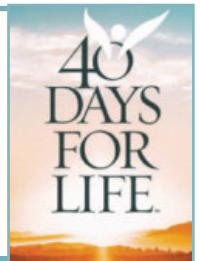

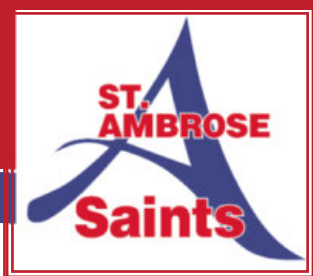

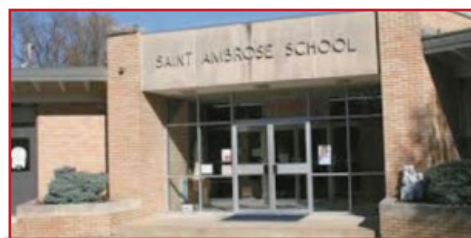
