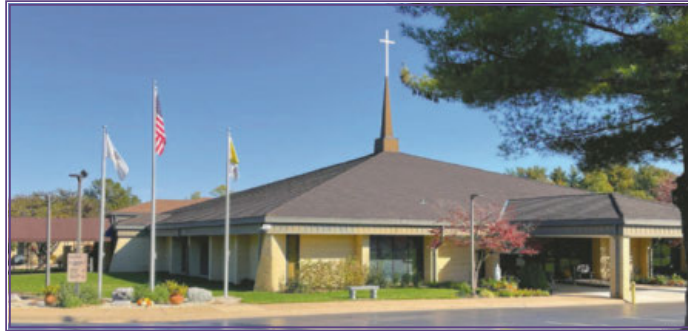

Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Ambrose Parish Family,

In the Gospel for this Fifth Sunday of Lent, we are told that some Greeks approached the apostle Philip and said, "Sir, we would like to see Jesus." We are very blessed at St. Ambrose that so many have been making the same request to us. Many of these people have decided to follow Jesus and will be baptized at the Easter Vigil. These are our **Elect**. This weekend, we celebrated the third and final Scrutiny with them at the 4:30 p.m. Mass where we heard and reflected upon the story of the raising of Lazarus from the dead.

Lent is a time of new life. The word **LENT** comes from the Old English for **springtime** ... when daylight lasts longer. In the life of the baptized, this new life is experienced in a unique and powerful way through the sacrament of Reconciliation.

I encourage you to attend the **Parish Communal Penance Service** this Sunday afternoon (March 17, 2024) beginning at 3:30 p.m., concluding with the Evening Prayer of the Church and Rosary (for those who wish to stay).

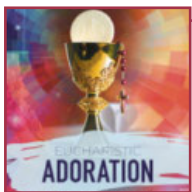


Happy **St. Patrick's Day** to all of you this weekend!

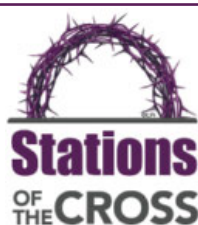

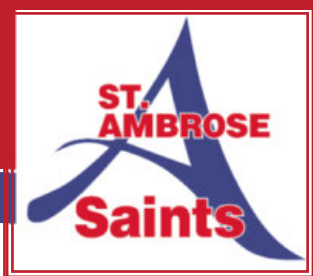
## Madison County Catholic Charities Hosts 23rd Help On The Move Annual Fundraiser Saturday, April 13 from 6 – 11 p.m.
