





We have two more testimonials from our newest members to share today, and one more next week. This happens because of God's grace and by the faithful example of our Parish Community. God bless each of us for our prayerful support and faithful example.

Today's Gospel is a continuation of one of my favorites. Two of the Disciples were leaving Jerusalem on the way to Emmaus. It was a distance of 7 miles or so. They were so down, that when a "stranger" came up behind them, they did not even begin to realize who it was. St. Ambrose Parish & School Wish List of Needed Items | At St. Ambrose, we are blessed to be financially stable, with parishioners and friends of the parish that continue to generously give of their time, talent, and treasure. Despite this stability, year in and year out our parish and school face increasing expenses and financial challenges. We do this while continuously striving to improve in the many ministries for our parish and school families. Typically, our annual budget is very conservative, and it is only through the generosity of so many that we continue to remain financially stable and will remain viable for the future. This area of the bulletin is provided so that parishioners and friends of the parish are aware of our current needs and estimated expenses. These are expenses that St. Ambrose will have to absorb and any support for these costs is greatly appreciated.

Please remember that donations to school and Church projects are tax deductible. Thank you for your support!

- **Gymnasium Sound** | More than a year ago a generous donor provided funds to purchase new wireless microphones for our gym for student performances and more. That upgrade enhanced the sound in the gym. Recently, we ran into another new sound issue in the gym. One of the two speakers in the gym recently went out. Improving and enhancing the sound in the gym has been a goal and focus the last several years. We received quotes to replace the broken speaker and to upgrade the other necessary components of the gym sound system. These include:
 - 4 new speakers, a new mixer, speaker amplifiers, power conditioner, and AV cabling for new screens in the gym. This sound system will be connected to 3 new flat screen TVs that will be mounted in the gym to provide visual displays for games, assemblies/presentations, events, and more. The new speakers and the upgraded sound equipment is just under \$10,000.
- **Detailed Security Audit** | This past November, our Safety and Security Committee met for our bi-annual meeting. This committee is composed of current and retired members of law enforcement, most of which are parents to students in our school. These individuals have generously donated their time to help enhance security at St. Ambrose. This group has been meeting now for almost 3 years and have helped identify the projects that will be completed (hopefully this Summer) with our IEMA grant funds. The Safety and Security Committee suggested our next step to improve security would be to hire a company to provide St. Ambrose a detailed security audit. This audit would cover our entire St. Ambrose campus (*Church, Community Center, School, and Rectory*) and the audit would identify realistic and important future enhancements to safety and security at St. Ambrose. To have a security firm complete this audit, will cost approximately \$2,500.

St. Ambrose Catholic School Alumni Success | We congratulate our alumni and their continued success at our local high schools and beyond in college and in the professional world. Recent graduates at Marquette Catholic High School have achieved many accomplishments. Some of these include MCHS National Honor Society inductions. In the last few years, our St. Ambrose alumni have represented 20-30%+ of each new class of NHS inductees. Each year our students represent about 10-15% of a MCHS class and our NHS inductions double or triple our population representation. Of 16 St. Ambrose graduates at MCHS this year, 8 of them were on high honor roll and 3 more on honor roll. On Friday we learned that 3 of our 8th graders placed in the top 10% on the Marquette Catholic High School entrance exam. They represent 1/3 of the 9 students that were in the top 10% for next year's Freshman class at MCHS. In addition to this information, this past Fall, our MAP test scores were one of the best in the area and one of the best in the Diocese. As we look to grow and improve it is important to recognize and reflect on our students' many successes!
